

AMELIA TOKARSKA

Harpist soloist, chamber musician, orchestral player, and pedagogue. Amelia is a graduate of the Royal Conservatory of Brussels and the Academy of Performing Arts in Prague in the harp class of Prof. Jana Boušková. She also enriches her education by participating in the programs of the Czech Academy of Chamber Music and the Villa Musica Rheinland-Pfalz Academy (Germany). Amelia is a laureate of national and international competitions, including the Prof. Karel Patras International Harp Competition in Prague and the Jeunesses Musicales Interpretation Competition She had the pleasure of performing during the XII World Harp Congress in Sydney and the XIV World Harp Congress in Cardiff. She performs both in her home country - Poland and abroad, having performed in countries such as Australia, Austria, Belgium, Belarus, Brazil, Czech Republic, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Switzerland, Ukraine, and the United Kingdom. Amelia's artistic achievements have been recognized through scholarships from the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage, the Visegrad Scholarship, and the Director of the Center for Artistic Education. She is currently the first harpist of the Bohuslav Martinů Philharmonic Orchestra in Zlín (Czech Republic).

SYLVIE SCHELINGEROVÁ - FLUTE AMELIA TOKARSKA - HARP

Amelia Tokarska and Sylvie Neumann Schelingerová met in 2017 during the Chamber Music Academy founded by Tomas Jamnik. Since then, they have been performing together at concerts in Poland and the Czech Republic, where Sylvie comes from.During their studies, the artists prepared works under the supervision of outstanding professors such as Jana Bouskova, Ana Brateljevic, Jan Ostry, Jakub Fišer, and Jan Soucek. The duo's repertoire includes works from Baroque to contemporary music (e.g., J.S. Bach, L. Spohr, G. Rossini, G. Donizetti, L. Sluka, W. Lutosławski, A. Piazzolla...). At concerts, the duo also performs unique French repertoire from the 19th and 20th centuries (C. Debussy, M. Ravel, G. Bizet, C. Saint-Saens, G. Faure, and others). They also have Mozart's Concerto for Flute and Harp in C major in their repertoire, which they performed with the Teplice Philharmonic and the Czech Chamber Music Academy Orchestra.

Harplino Duet - the Polish-Brazilian duo was created in 2017 by two talented young artists Jessé Reis and Amelia Tokarska. The artists set themselves the goal of promoting chamber music that combines musical cultures and traditions. Their repertoire includes both classical and South American music. The duo performed at many festivals in Poland and abroad - Brazil (International Music Festival of Campos do Jordão), Belgium, Germany, Austria, Czech Republic (Praha Harp Festival). Amelia and Jessé are laureates of the 8th International Harp Duet Competition. In 2022, they performed at the XIV World Harp Congress in Wales, giving a recital of music by the Polish composer Roman Ryterband.

Amelia regularly collaborates with the Academic Choir of the Silesian University of Technology under the direction of Tomasz Giedwiłło.
